That's what drew hockey legend and Atlanta Thrashers' goalie, Kari Lehtonen, to Distinctive after purchasing a 17-year-old Brookhaven home. Realizing the potential it had, Kari bought the house in 2006 and began the design process the day of the closing. Jill Weber, Distinctive's kitchen designer and NARI Certified Remodeler explains, "The home didn't know what it wanted to be. It was a mix between a Cape Cod cottage and a contemporary. The inside was very early 80's and needed updating to make this house the home Lehtonen wanted it to be."

With a vision in mind, Weber and the team at Distinctive set out to create an ultra chic, urban home with European influences. Each room in the 3,000-square-foot home was renovated, customizing the lighting, fixtures, tile and layout to Lehtonen's background and lifestyle. He became more involved in the design and renovation as time went on, adding his taste and touch to each room as Distinctive encourages clients to do.

It is the kitchen, however, that now holds Lehtonen's supreme attention. Buelow and his team replaced the traditional breakfast nook with a custom glass-top bar, installed marble tile in a 1x1 checkerboard pattern on the kitchen backsplash and back of the bar, replaced basic windows with modern etched glass and updated the kitchen with custom dark-wood Poggenpohl cabinetry, brushed aluminum fixtures and featured lighting that revolves colors.
